- Accessibility laws

- First online classes 20 years ago
- Small Academic Technology department
- No official online policy
- Quality is Department driven
- First Instructional Designer - 2016
- First Quality Assurance rubric distributed – 2016
 - CHICO rubric
- HSU joins OLC 2017 – 1 year
 - Paid by School of Business
- HSU joins QM 2018 – still a member
 - Paid by School of Business

Quality Matters



Growth

Currently the most well known Quality Assurance process in the US and is found internationally. More than 1500 colleges and Universities have been a part of QM.



Clear Process

Provides clear steps and guidance for faculty to build courses in ways that meet laws and best practices. Their certification would also assure they learn quality content using quality processes.



Webinars & Research

Membership allows access to QM content for all members. Some courses and resources have a cost, but much of their other content is free. Attend April 9th to learn more from Trudi Sabaj.

QM Rubric

- More Costly than others
- Updated regularly
- Multiple rubrics
 - Higher Ed Online
 - Higher Ed F2F
 - Etc...
- 80% standard
- 3 point items are vital elements
- Rubric

Other Options

- OLC
 - Not as popular as QM, but similar structure
 - Focuses more on improvement rather than a grade
 - Rubric - <https://onlinelearningconsortium.org/consult/oscqr-course-design-review/>
- CHICO rubric
 - Not widely used, but used during our BbLearn migration
 - Great starter rubric/guidelines
 - Rubric - <https://www.csuchico.edu/eoi/rubric.shtml>

- **Quality Assurance Overview:**
Some form of quality assurance is very important for faculty to ensure they meet all legal practices and create the best experience for their students.
- **Quality Matters:**
Henderson is part of QM, and you can participate in many webinars for free. You can also peruse a lot of their information at no cost.
- **Other Options:**
You are not required to use QM. There are other options out there like the CHICO rubric or the OLC's Quality Scorecard Rubric. The key is to find a good rubric that helps ensure you think about important items that may be forgotten or overlooked.
